Annual Catholic Appeal

Final Report for Summer Campaign 2014

The 2014 Annual Catholic Appeal officially came to a close this past January 31st. Diocese-wide, just under 3 million dollars from more than 19,000 families was pledged. Last year alone, more than 120,000 lives were touched by the generosity of Catholics in our diocese. Our parish raised \$21,639, a 16% increase from 2013 despite a 24% decrease in participants. This occurring so soon after the kickoff of the One Campaign is amazing and your generosity is deeply appreciated. This resulted in \$5,410 being returned to the parish. This money is used in its entirety to feel and assist the local needy of the community.
