## Petition Against Physician Assisted Suicide

Bishop Soto has encouraged every parish in the diocese to gather signatures for the Physician Assisted Suicide Referendum after each mass this weekend. It is a rare occurrence for the Bishops of California to engage a public referendum in this fashion but the new moral challenge this law presents urges us to cooperate with those who are working to stop the dangerous practice of physician-assisted suicide before it is implemented. There will be volunteers at each of the exits gathering signatures for the campaign. You must be 18 years or older, and registered in this county to participate.
