## **Lent (Feb. 10 - Mar. 23)**

Lent prepares the faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery of Christ's suffering, death and resurrection. It is a time for reflection and spiritual renewal, a time to examine one's relationships with God and with others. The Church also calls Catholics to a spirit of penance, above all to practice the "Acts of Religion": fasting, prayer and almsgiving, "which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, nos. 1969 and 1434)

### **Fast and Abstinence (Self-Denial)**

To foster the spirit of penance and of reparation for sin, to encourage self-denial, and to guide us in the footsteps of Jesus, Church law requires the observance of fast and abstinence (CCC nos. 1249-1253).

1. **Abstinence:** All persons, 14 years and older, are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
2. **Fasting:** Everyone, from ages 18 to 59, is obliged to fast and on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Voluntary fasting on other weekdays of Lent, especially on Wednesdays and Fridays, is highly recommended. Fasting is generally understood to mean that one full meal may be eaten. Two other small meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be eaten; but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Other forms of fasting, especially from alcoholic beverages, needless television, video games, internet, and social entertainment is of true spiritual value and is strongly encouraged.

If you take medications for serious, continuous illnesses, then you are not bound by any of the disciplines during Lent. However, if you wish to abstain from meat during Lent, you may receive full approval from your physician.
