St. Francis "Blessing of the Animals"

On Sunday, Oct. 2nd, churches around the world will celebrate something that St. Francis began nearly 800 years ago: Blessing of the Animals. Francis first introduced the idea that human beings are only one of many of God's creatures, and all are blessed in God's "eyes". While his feast day is October 4th, the blessing is usually scheduled for the Sunday closest to the feast day.

According to one legend, the first blessing happened while St. Francis was praying alone to God. He saw some birds along his path and began to preach to them about God's glory. He showed a love for nature around him that set him apart from other people. The message to those of us with animal companions is the same: take care of them as you would take care of yourself. Show gratitude; they are gifts from God.
