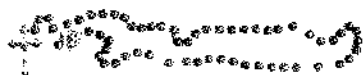
## 2016 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity January 18-25, 2016

The service will be held at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00 pm. Auxiliary Bishop Cotta will be introducing the worship service and this year's guest speaker, Bishop W. Darin Moore from the AME Zion Church, who will be speaking on the 2016 theme: "Called to Proclaim the Acts of the Lord" (1 Peter 2: 9-10). The public is cordially invited.
