The Missionary Cooperative Appeal is an annual program in which missionaries from around the world speak at each parish. The goal of this appeal is to increase awareness of missionary work and to raise funds to help missionary organizations continue their evangelization efforts. "ONE Campaign" Progress Report

As of 3/31/2016, the total that our Parish has pledged and one-time gifted is \$125,127.00. Of that, \$72,819.00 has been received. As you know, for every dollar raised at our Parish through the ONE Campaign, we receive 25 percent up to our parish goal, or \$31,281.75. After that, we receive 67 percent of each dollar raised above and beyond our goal. To date, we have received \$18,205.00.

The generosity of all those participating in the ONE Campaign is appreciated now more than ever. Only through the fulfillment of each parishioner's commitment will the designated parish projects, education, youth ministry, pastoral care, communication and service ministries reach full funding.

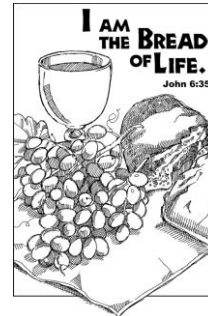
